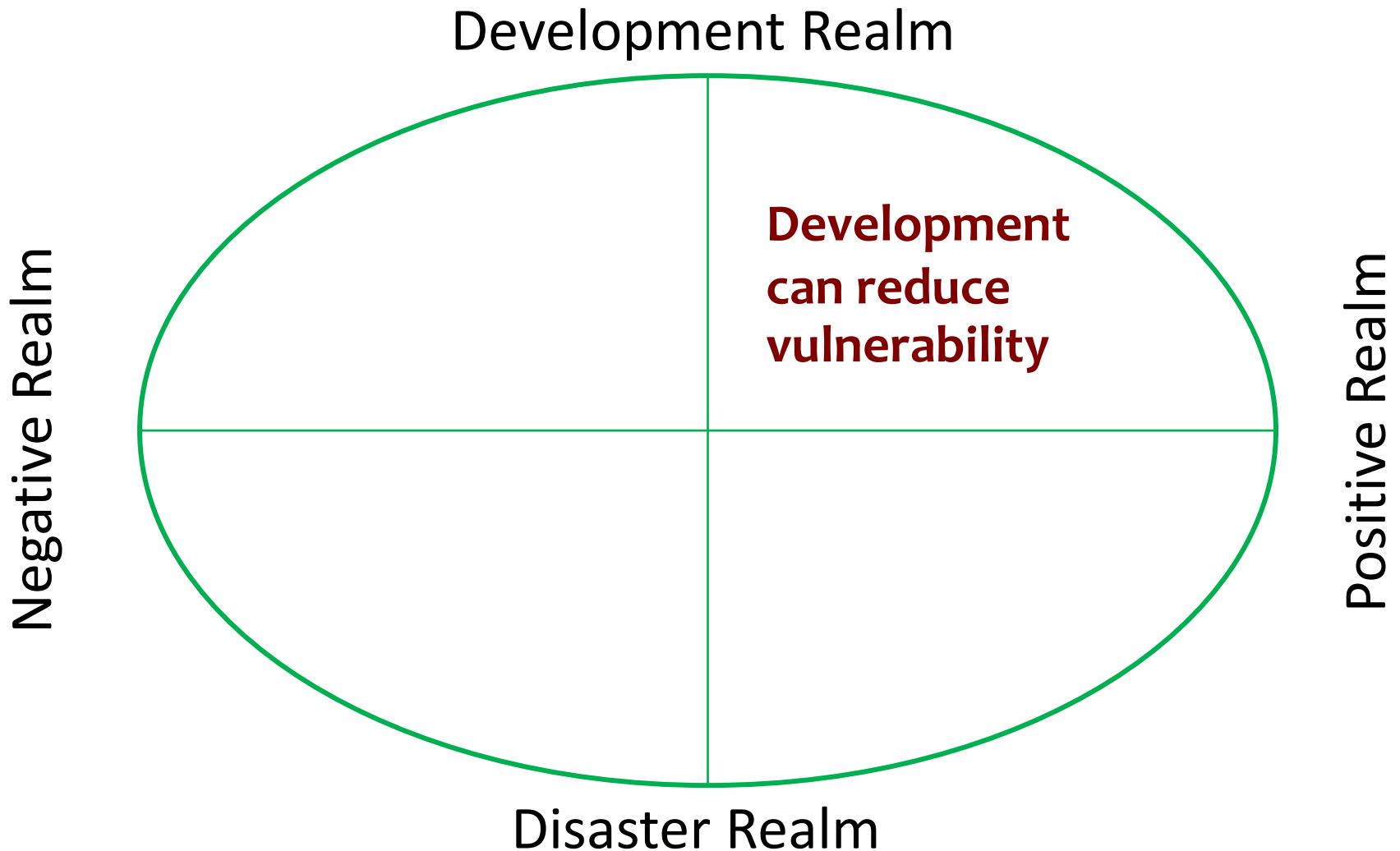

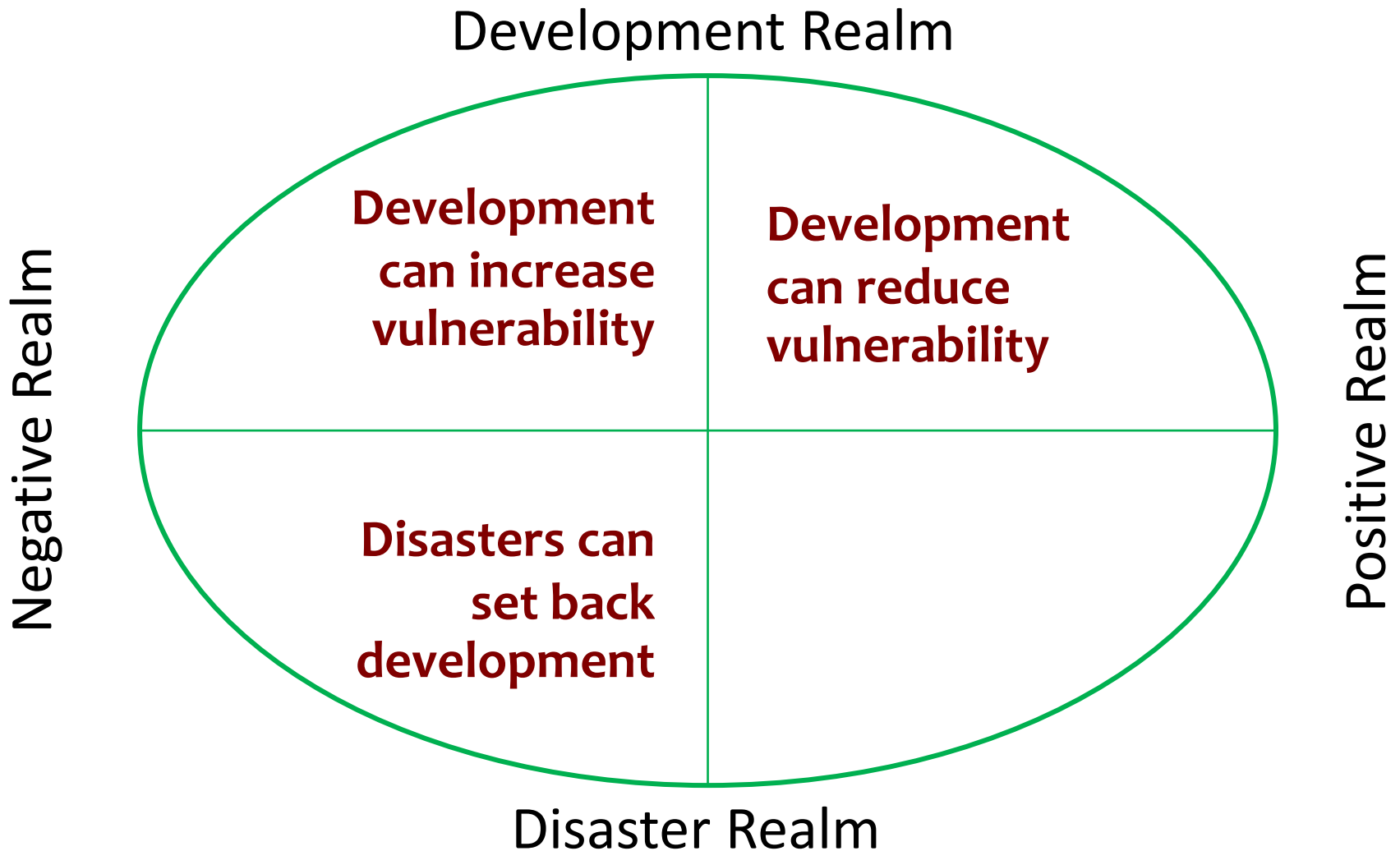
What happens to Development when Disaster occurs?

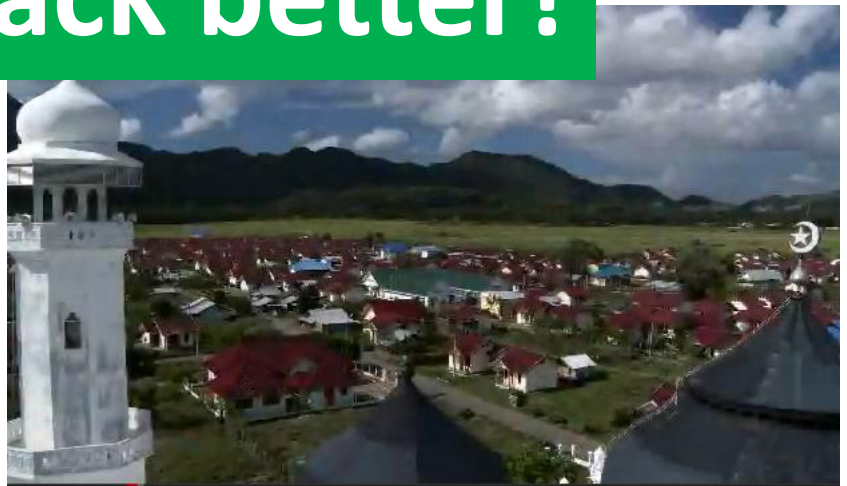

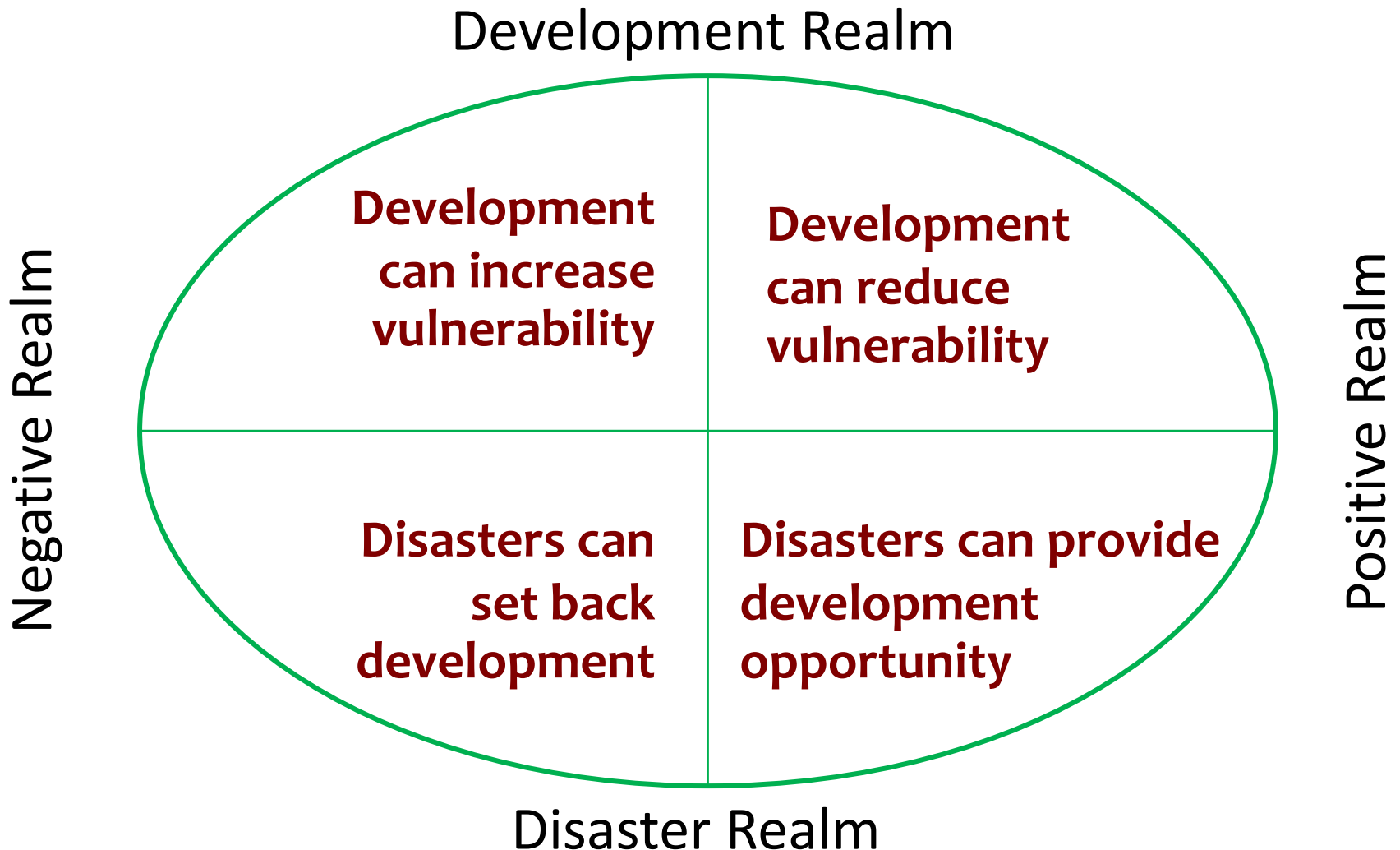
What can we do with development after Disaster took place?
